

Altrusa Club of Statesboro Martha Tootle Cain Scholarship Application Material 2022-2023 Academic Year

Purpose

To provide scholarship assistance to an undergraduate female student who demonstrates financial need as well as integrity, academic success, and willingness to serve her community. The main criteria for award of the scholarship will be how well the candidate meets the requirements specified within these materials.

The Altrusa Scholarship:

Scholarship Funds:

- 1. The scholarship is \$1000.00 per academic term for the fall and spring terms. It can only be awarded for one year of study at Ogeechee Tech or Georgia Southern University.
- 2. The scholarship award may be applied toward tuition, books, required fees, or any expenses associated with attending the academic institution.
- 3. Payment of the scholarship awarded will be made directly to the student.

Recipient Eligibility:

- 1. The recipient(s) must have completed a year of study, be enrolled as a full-time student, and have at least two more semesters of study left in an undergraduate program.
- 2. The recipient(s) must maintain a minimum of a 3.0 GPA fall semester of the award in order to be eligible to receive the scholarship spring semester.
- 3. Non-traditional students are encouraged to apply.

Procedures for Scholarship Award:

1. The Altrusa Scholarship Committee will accept applications from candidates until April 1, 2022.

- 2. Scholarship applicants will be interviewed by Committee members in April 2022.
- 3. Scholarship awards will be announced no later than May 2, 2022.
 - a. Notification will be sent to all applicants thanking them for their application.
 - b. The Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee will notify the recipient(s) of the award by letter or email.
 - i. The recipient(s) will be presented to the entire organization at one of the scheduled meetings.

Criteria for Qualification as a Candidate

<u>Submission Deadline</u>: All applicants must submit a completed scholarship application to the Altrusa Scholarship Committee no later than April 1, 2022.

<u>Statement of Purpose</u>: All applicants are to include a separate statement of purpose that answers the following questions:

- 1. Why do you wish to be considered for this scholarship?
- 2. What are your goals after completing your present course of study?

Requirements for Applicants:

- 1. Applicants must submit a transcript that shows course work completed. (If awarded the scholarship, the recipient will need to present an official transcript indicating being registered for proposed course work for the semesters of the scholarship award.)
- 2. Students need to indicate on the application scholarships being received and part time jobs held (including how many hours/week working and where).
- 3. All applications will be reviewed by the committee and selected applicants will be interviewed (in person *or electronically*).
